Preparation is the formula for success at any horse show! It is an important life skill.

Topics covered:

Students

Disciplines -What is horse showing and what are the different “disciplines”

Show entry & forms – What do I need to do to enter??

Attire – what to wear – what’s proper for different horse shows

What to bring to a horse show – the list (forms, money, tack, etc.)

Tack cleaning – Saddle, Bridle, what to wash a night or two before

Preparing your horse – pulling the mane, trimming, bathing, hoof care

Braiding – how to make button and hunter braids, tail braids

Shipping – packing the trailer, shipping boots, how to prepare the trailer, how to load on the trailer, how to make a safety release knot

Overnight trips – extras to pack on the trailer, important forms to have with you when traveling
